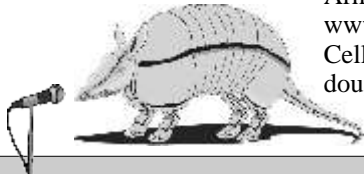

Bluegrass Festival !

This is the 11th annual "Laughing Waters" Bluegrass Festival, and the 11th annual attempt to describe just what the heck Bluegrass Music is. While there are enough exceptions to disqualify any narrow definition, bluegrass *usually* involves certain acoustic instruments (5-string banjo, fiddle, mandolin, "flat-top" guitar and upright "dog-house" bass) and "tight" two or three part harmony singing. You don't have to sing like you just staggered out of the mountains and don't know how to use a knife and fork, and you don't have to play a million miles per hour. But it helps.

In the Twin Cities area, you can hear bluegrass regularly on Friday and Saturday nights at Dulono's Pizza (see their ad in this program). On Saturday mornings, tune in to KBEM's "Bluegrass Saturday Morning" show (88.5 FM). Also check out MBOTMA, the Minnesota Bluegrass and Old-Time Music Association.

Don't be shy about talking to the musicians performing today! Bluegrass is just about the only music where most of the audience plays too (and sometimes just as well as the pros!)

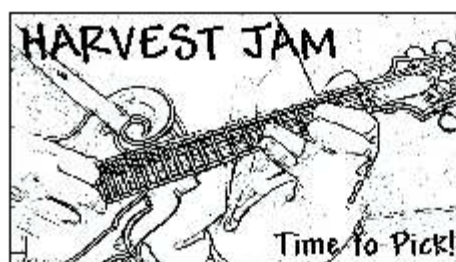

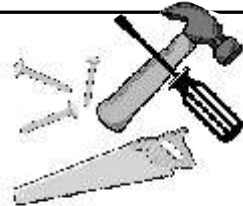

The High 48s

New for 2009!

Since forming in 2006, The High 48s have grabbed the attention of festival audiences in the Upper Midwest and beyond, toured steadily, released two critically acclaimed CDs and won first place in the 2008 RockyGrass Band Competition in Lyons, Colorado.

The High 48s play bluegrass in the traditional style, with close three-part harmonies sung around a single microphone. But the High 48s don't draw their material exclusively from the hallowed back catalogs of bluegrass's "first generation," artists such as Bill Monroe, Flatt and Scruggs, and Jimmy Martin. The High 48s focus instead on writing original material that combines the soul and drive of first-generation bluegrass with the harder-edged sound of alternative country and roots rock. It's a style of music the band calls Hard Grass.

The High 48s are Rich Casey (bass), Eric Christopher (fiddle and vocals), Tony Ihrig (banjo), Chad Johnson (mandolin and vocals), and his brother Derek Johnson (guitar and vocals).

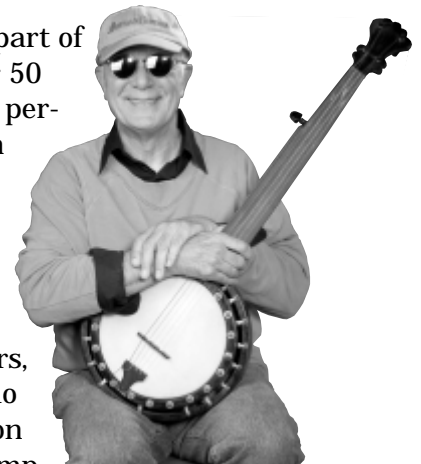

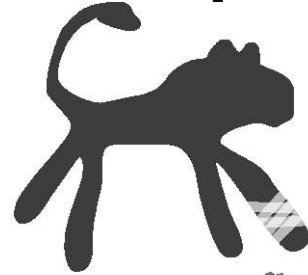
